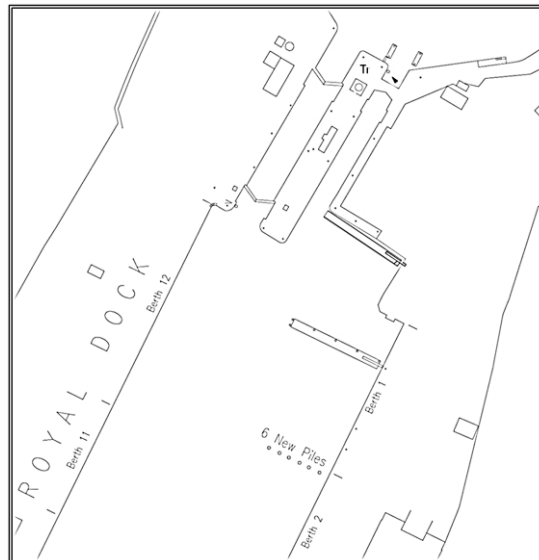

## **R I V E R H U M B E R**

### **GRIMSBY ROYAL DOCK – CONSTRUCTION OF CREW TRANSFER VESSEL PONTOON**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that commencing Friday 17 October 2025 (or as soon after as circumstances permit) and continuing for a period of approximately two weeks, piling works will be undertaken as part of the construction of a new 45m crew transfer vessel pontoon at number one quay within Grimsby Royal Dock.



6 piles will be installed approximately 75m South of the current pontoon on berth number 1. The outermost pile will be positioned 45m into the Dock and will be lit with two fixed red navigation lights positioned vertically.

These works will be conducted within daylight hours only and all works will be paused during the level period HW -1.5hrs to HW.

The vessels '**REBECCA M**', '**JOHN ELLIOT**', '**MORTLIFT**' and '**TORC**' will be operating within the Dock for the works and will be monitoring VHF channel 74 at all times.

**MARINERS ARE REQUESTED** to exercise care and caution in the area and when transiting the lock.

**MARINERS ARE FURTHER REQUESTED** to contact the Assistant Dock Master, callsign 'Royal Dock' when approaching the area of works.
